


Cloud Native: CNCF (2015)

 - and dynamically orchestrating those containers to optimize resource utilization







- Analyzed thousands of open source projects and ranked the projects according to four factors, which included:
 - Public interest in the project, as measured by Google search activity;
 - User activity, gauged by mentions of the projects on the popular techdiscussion board Stack Overflow:
 - Jobs impact, measured by the number of job postings citing each opensource project listed on the job boards Indeed and Simply Hired; and
 - Impact in the open-source community, tracked by measuring a project's influence on GitHub.
- Data & Analytics and DevOps are driving open source growth in the enterprise with well known projects such as Linux. Docker and Git
- With the successful IPOs of Mulesoft and Cloudera, there will be many more to come

- 9 code changes per hour
- \$100M in collective OSS funding






Number of Open Source Projects


