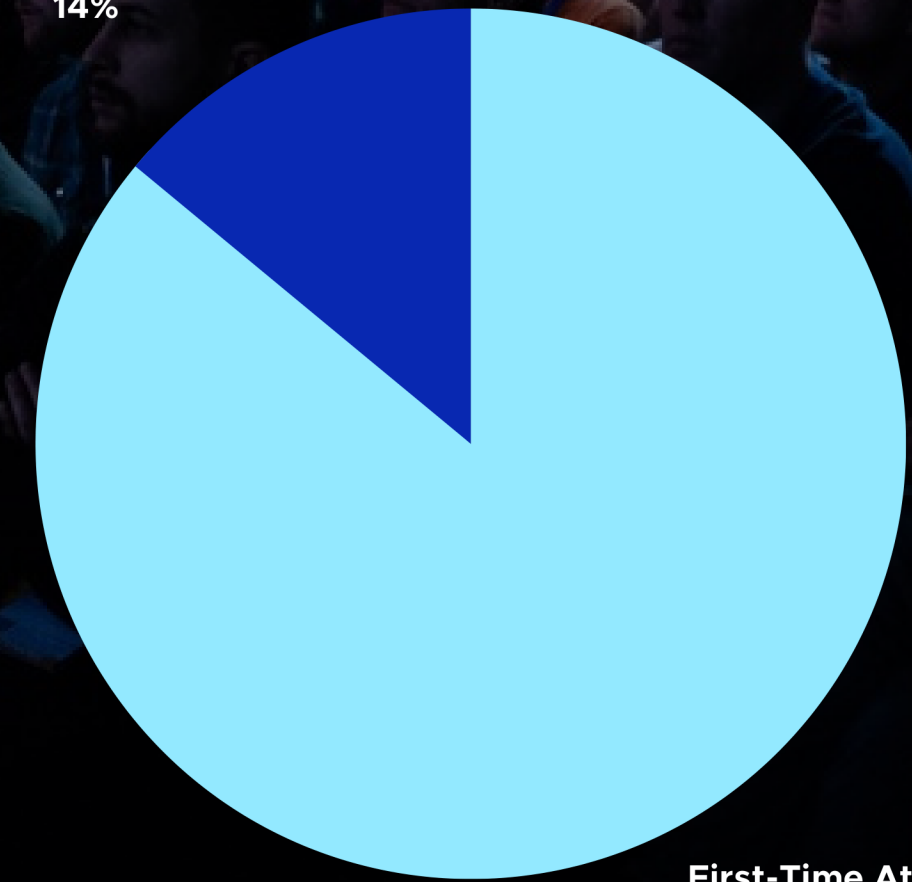

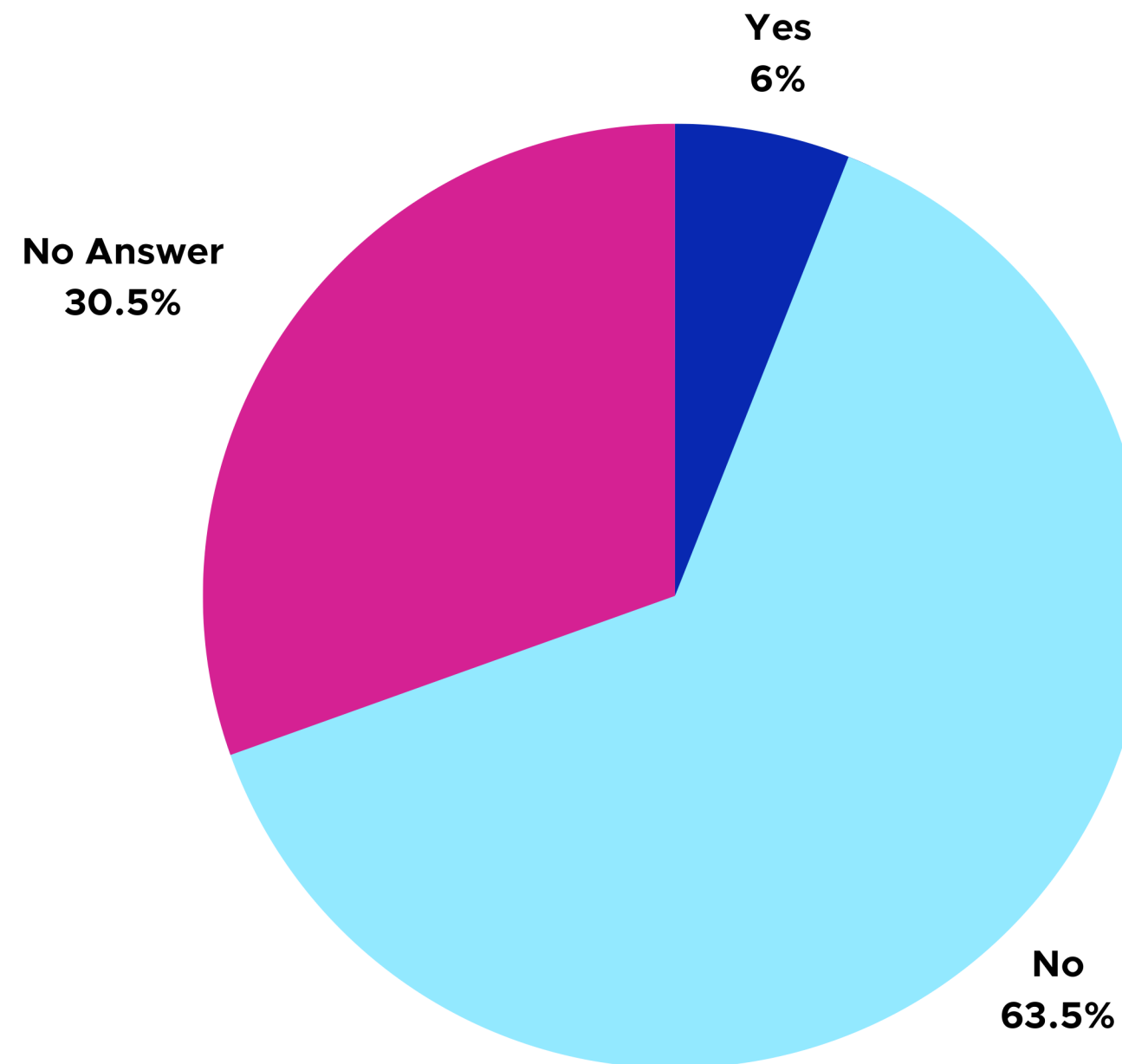

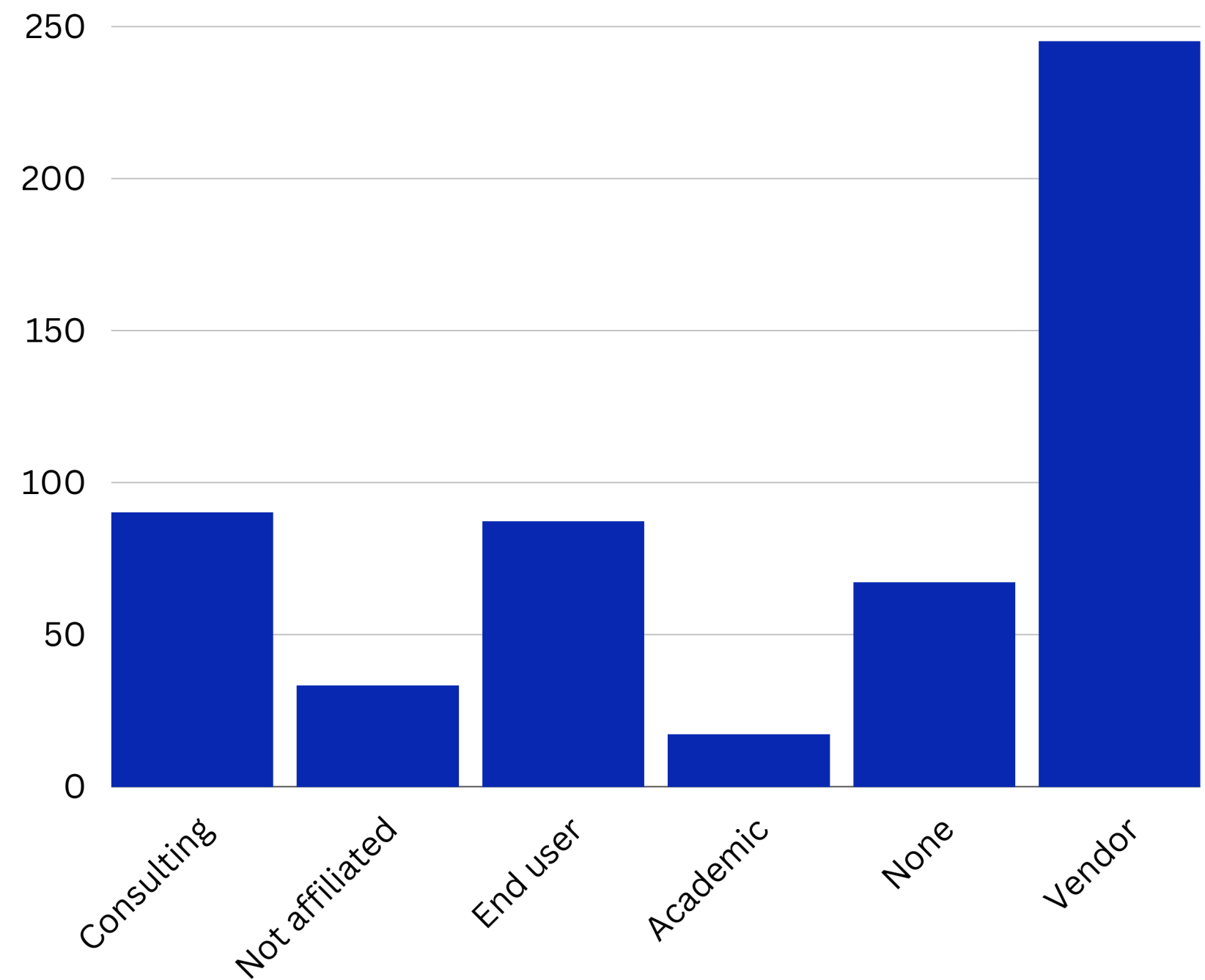

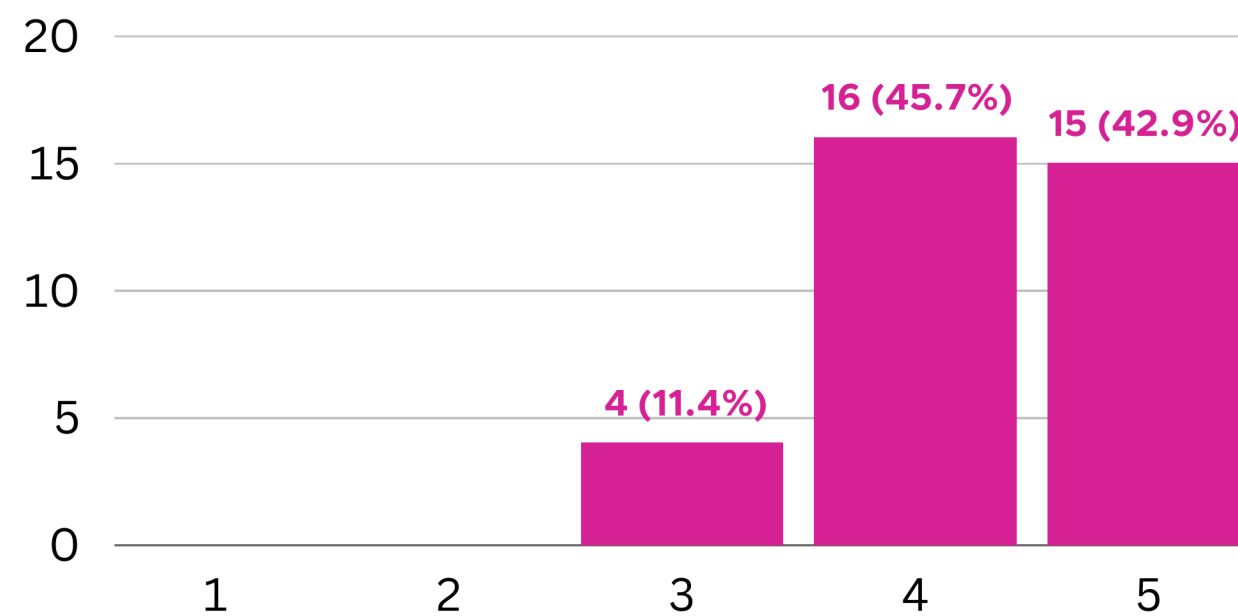

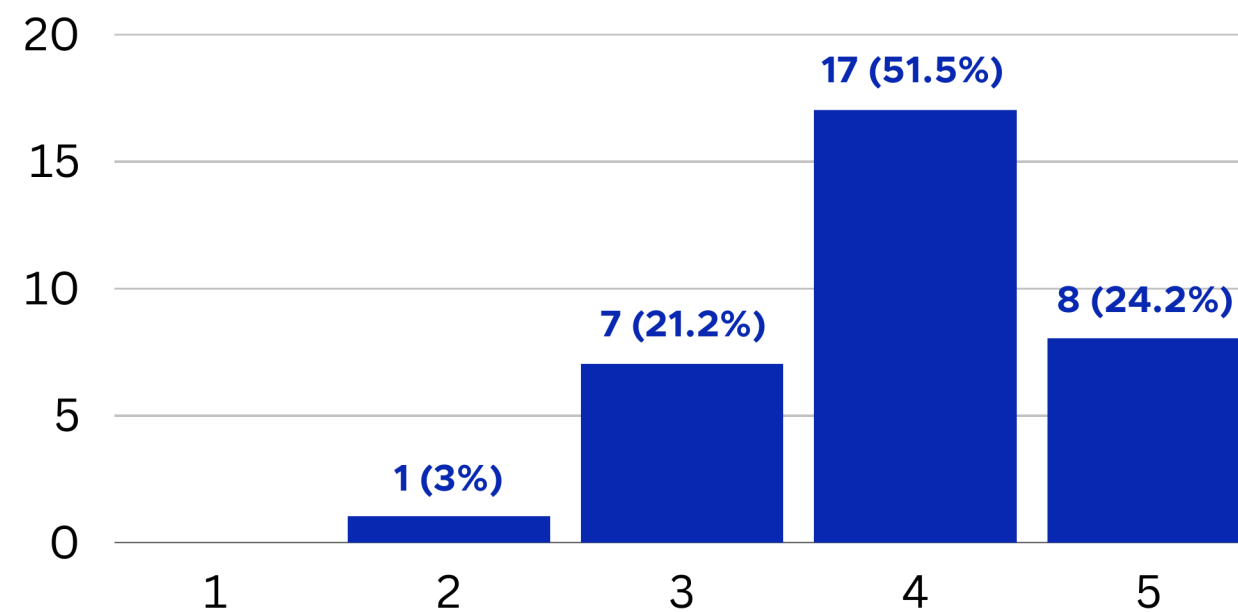
OVERALL SATISFACTION SCORE
