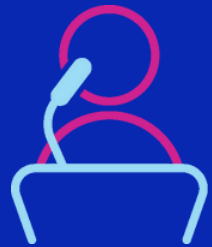

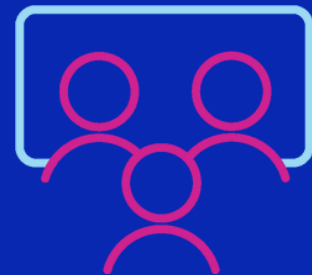
SPEAKERS & SESSIONS

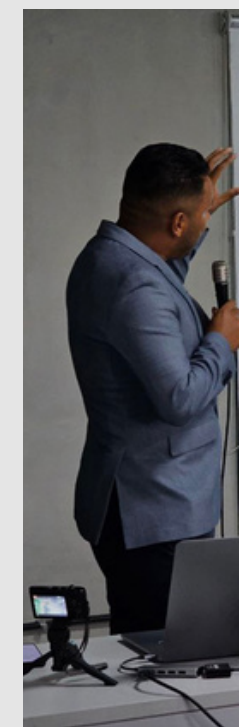

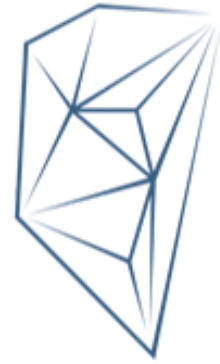

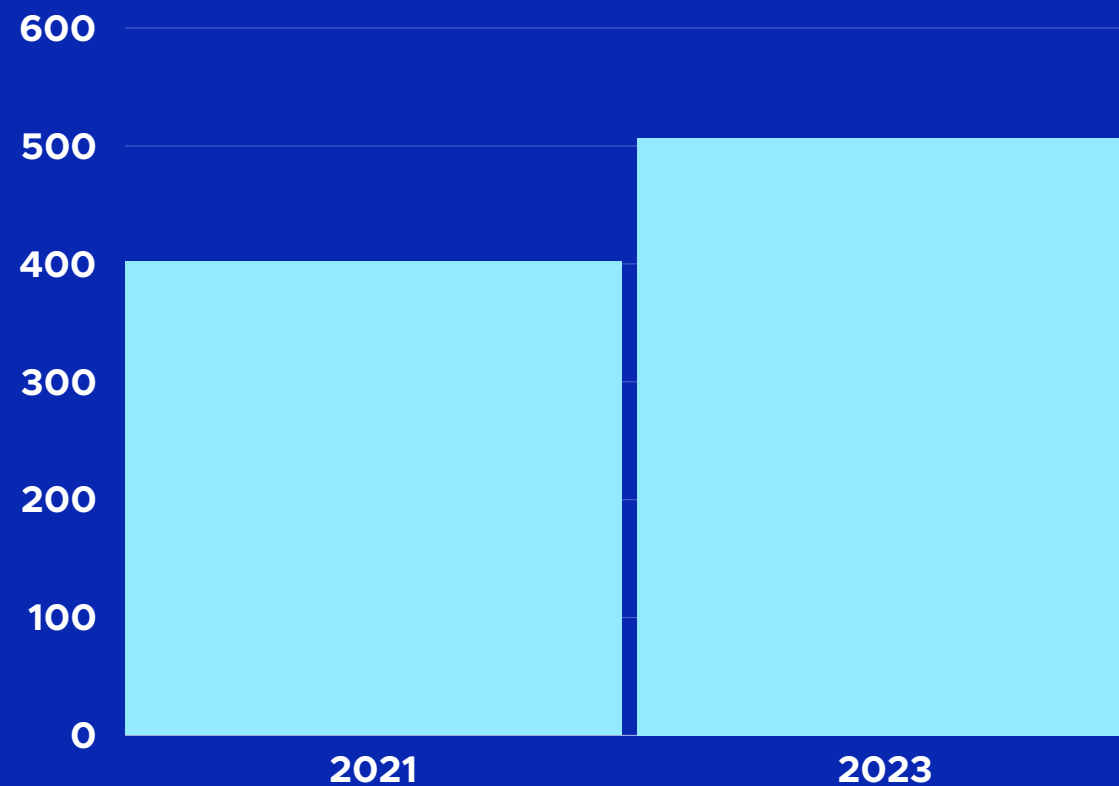
STATISTICS

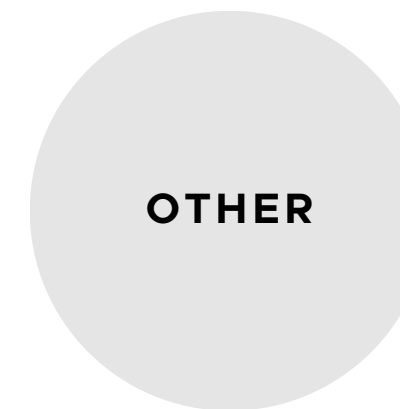

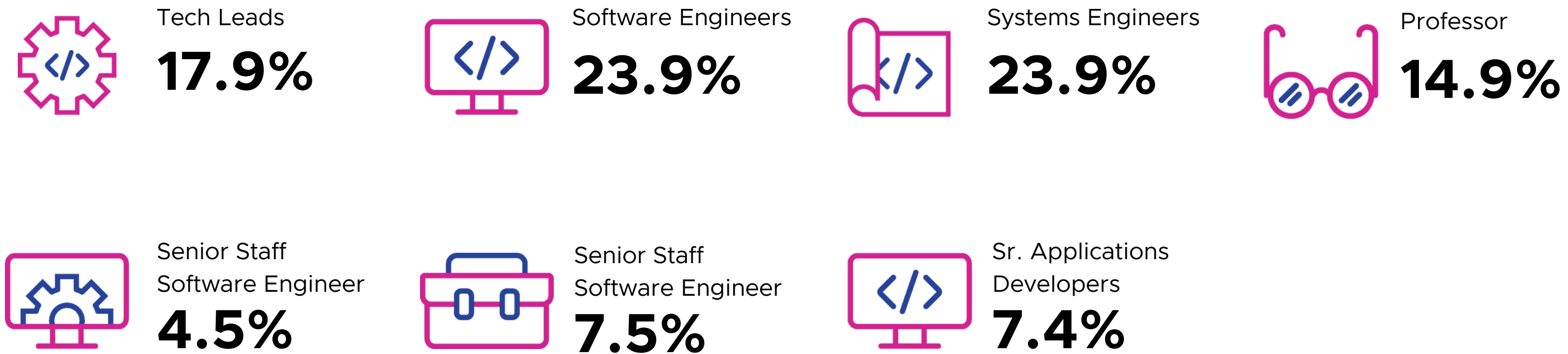

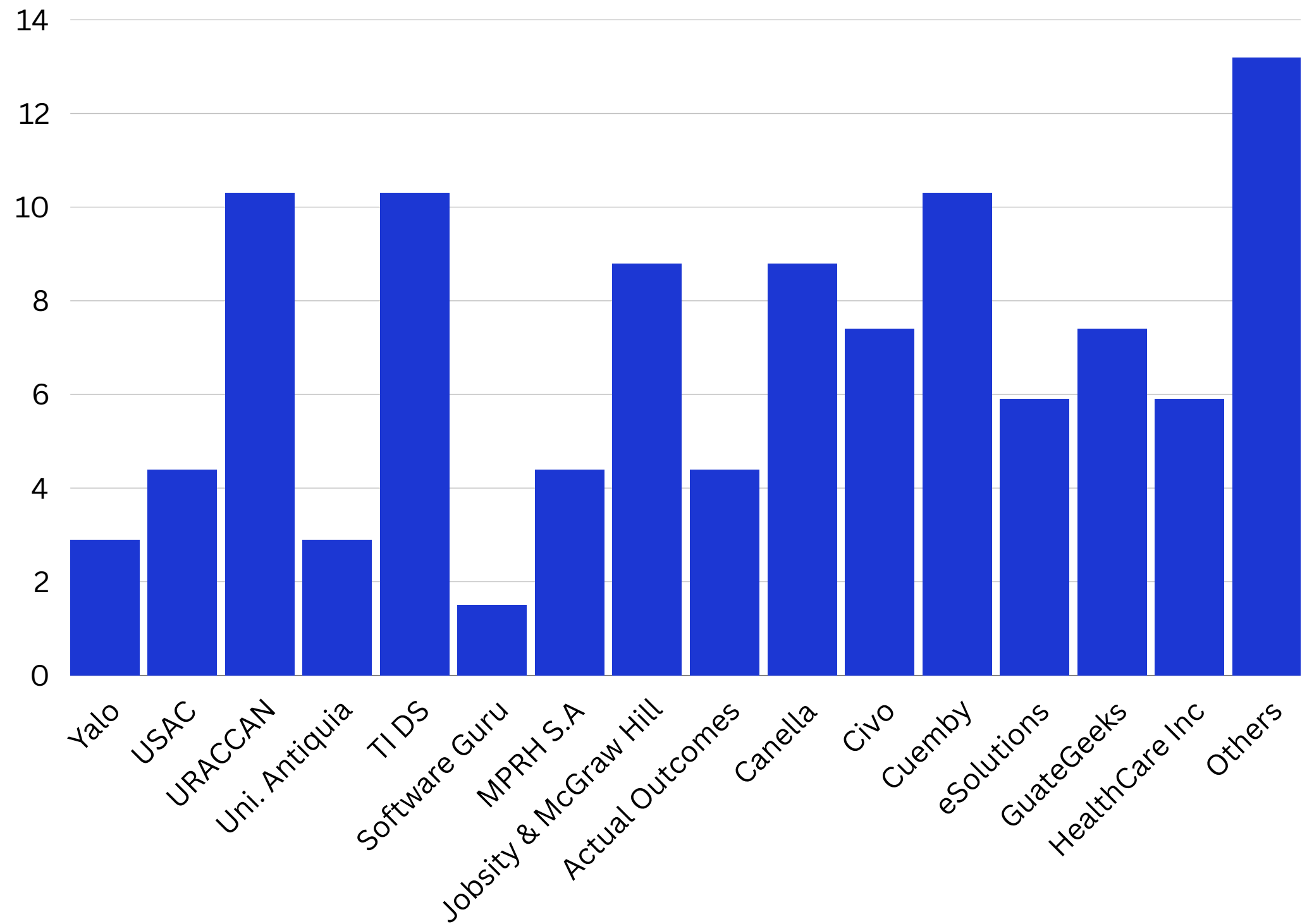
