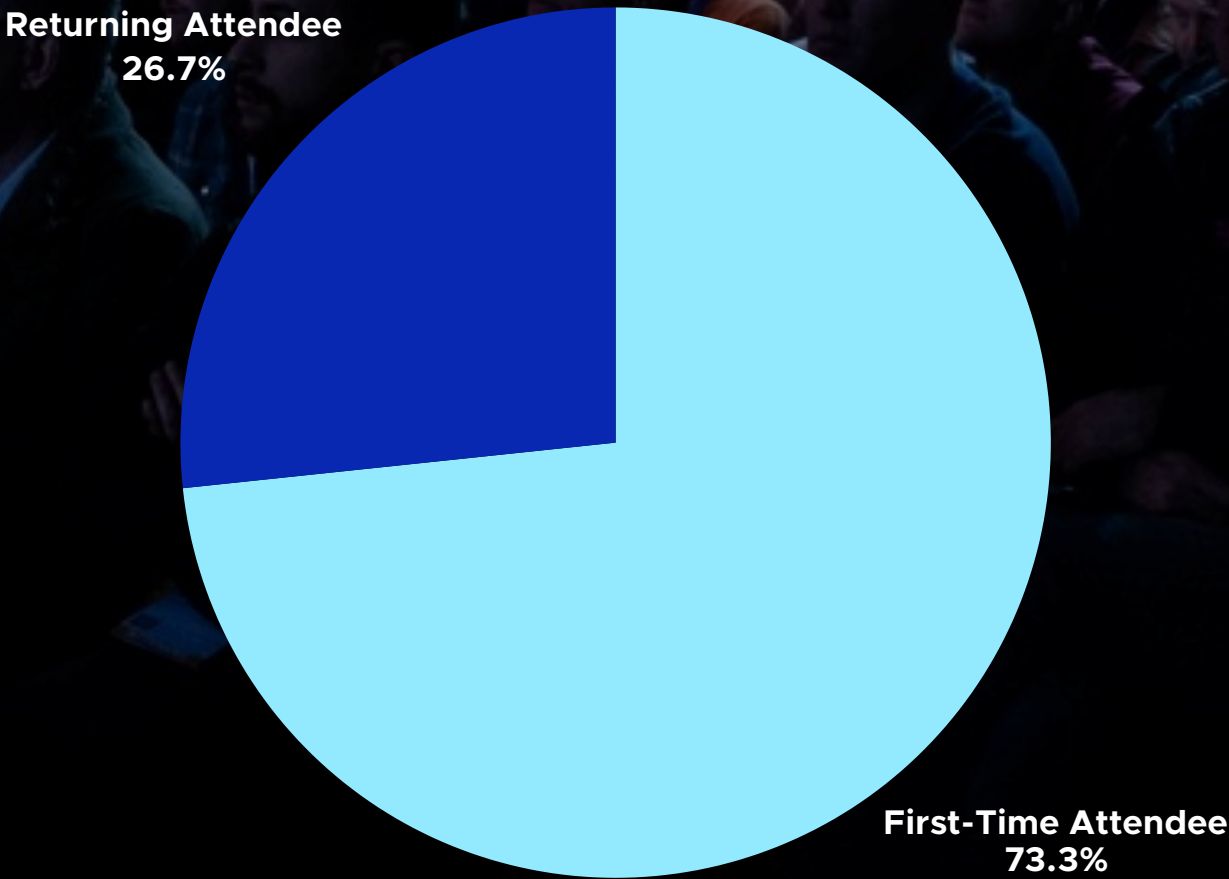
We are proud of the progress we have made in providing valuable insights and building a vibrant community during these unprecedented times.

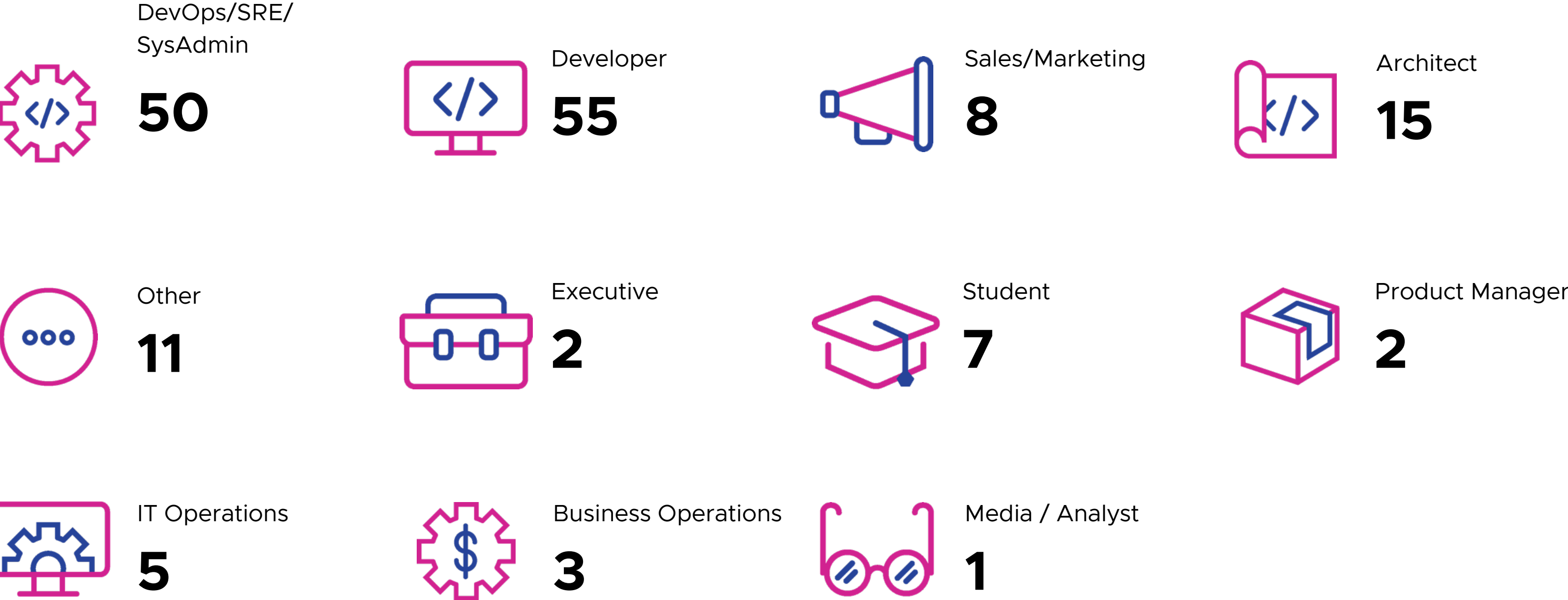

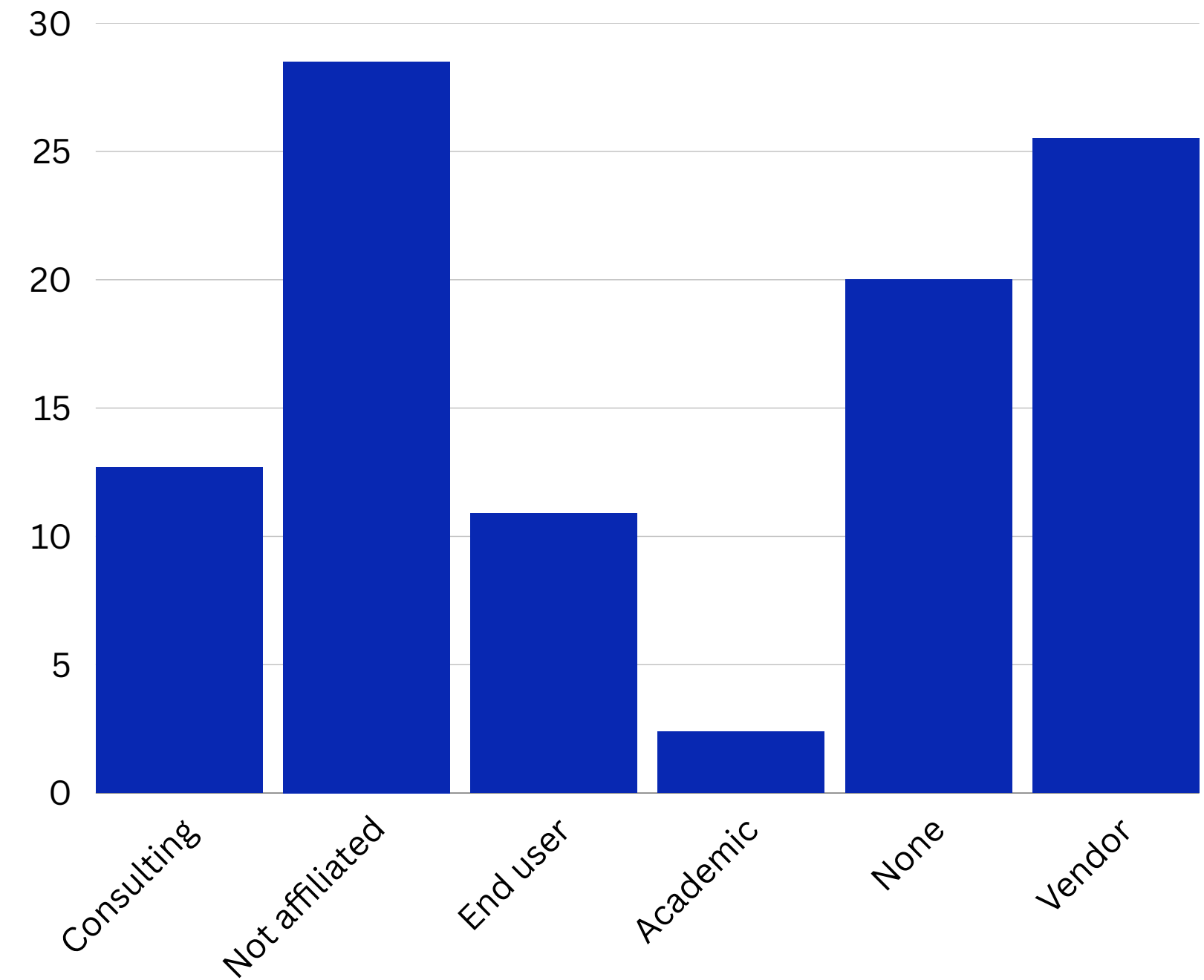
